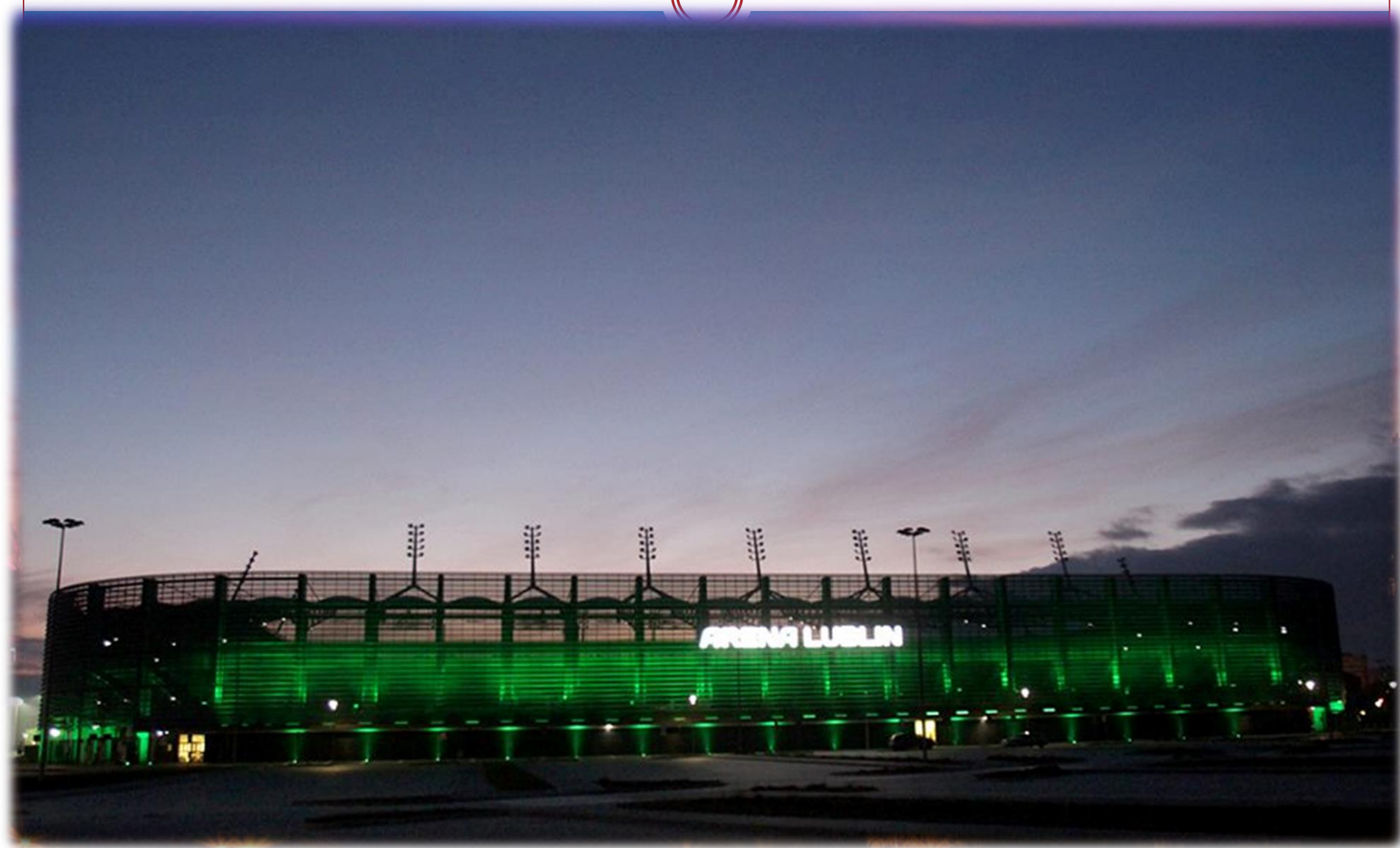

Lublin - important place on the map of the Polish Nursing



In 1969, with the effort of the Polish Nursing Association three-years nursing studies at the former Medical Academy of Lublin was established, which in **1972 was transformed into the Faculty of Nursing, Medical University of Lublin**. It was the first place in Eastern Europe of academic education of nurses.

Description Of The Structure Of Nursing Education



- ✓ Poland is a part of the Bologna Process from the beginning (from 1999). We have formally introduced it's propositions into nurses' education system together with provisions of UE Directives.
- ✓ Since 2000 nurses education in our country has changed completely.
- ✓ Education moved to Universities and High Vocational Schools. There are 80 academic institutions which educate nurses in Poland.

The first level of nursing education – Bachelor Degree in Nursing



- ✓ 3-level system of education was introduced together with ECTS and diploma supplement.
- ✓ Education in nursing is conducted only in the form of full-time studies.
- ✓ Bachelor's degree in nursing lasts not less than 6 semesters (3 years).
- ✓ The number of hours of education increased – minimum at the Bachelor level is not less than 4,720 hours (1/2 – practical education and 1/3 theoretical education) – 180 ECTS.

On each of the year students obtain 60 ECTS.

Diploma exam – 5 ECTS



In Poland professional license is obtained after student passes last professional exam. There are 3 parts of it:

- 1) student has to prepare Bachelor Thesis (it is assessed by supervisor and reviewer). Thesis is based on case study
- 2) theoretical exam: at this level student has to defend his thesis in front of the commission and answer to 3 questions from main nursing fields: surgical nursing, internal nursing and children nursing care;
- 3) when student passes this part he/she is allowed to do practical exam at the hospital ward (ward is randomly chosen).

Second level of nursing education



Master Degree in Nursing is obtained after two years of studies, student gained 120 ECTS (60 ECTS per year). Its includes minimum 1300

Student is obliged to prepare:

1. Master Thesis, when he gets positive assessment from supervisor and reviewer he then has to defend it in front of the commission.
1. After Thesis presentation and defense, there is also theoretical exam - questions are from entire period of studies.

Registered Nurse



According to Polish law, Registered Nurse is a nurse who:

- ✓ Obtained Bachelor Degree in Nursing
- ✓ Has full legal capacity to act
- ✓ Health status allows Her/Him to pursue the profession of nursing
- ✓ Shows impeccable ethical conduct



The third level of education – doctoral studies



Nursing as a scientific discipline has been placed under **the scientific ‘field’ of health sciences**, and in this field nurses can do PhD (4 years doctoral studies).

Doctorate in science allows nurses to independently **conduct research and work in institutions of higher education.**

Doctoral promotion ceremony



Nurse is required to participate in postgraduate education.

Types of postgraduate education in Poland:



1. **Specialization in nursing** (2 years) is aimed at achieving specialist knowledge and skills in a specific field of nursing.
2. **Qualification course** (6 months) is aimed at obtaining knowledge and skills to provide nursing care.
3. **Specialized courses** (minimum 4 weeks) is aimed at obtaining knowledge and skills to perform certain professional activities.
4. **Short courses** are aimed at developing and updating the knowledge and professional skills.

According to Regulation of the Minister of Health (2013)



Specializations for nurses that can be carried out in the fields:

- 1) anesthesia and intensive care nursing;
- 2) surgical nursing;
- 3) geriatric nursing;
- 4) nursing in internal medicine;
- 5) oncology nursing;
- 6) operating theatre nursing;
- 7) long-term care;
- 8) palliative care;
- 9) pediatric nursing;
- 10) mental health;
- 11) rescue nursing;
- 12) family nursing
- 13) epidemiological nursing
- 14) neonatal nursing
- 15) occupational medicine.

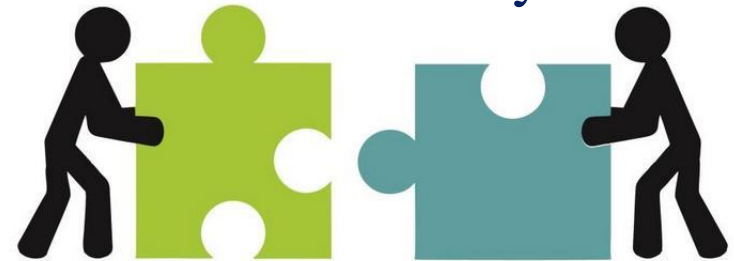
